**Big Idea:** Freedom comes not from rules or the lack of rules but from a personal relationship with Jesus who loves me and gave His life for me.

1. In A Daily Spiritual Tug-Of-War Of
"The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the <b>opposite</b> of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us <b>desires</b> that are the opposite of what the sinful nature
desires. These two forces are constantly fighting each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions." Galatians 5:17 (NLT2)
➤ If I Follow My, It Will Lead To "Those who live only to satisfy their own sinful nature will harvest decay and death
"Those who live only to satisfy their own sinful nature will harvest decay and death from that sinful nature." Galatians 6:8a (NLT2)
Sexual Sins: "When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, the results are very clear: sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures" Galatians 5:19 (NLT2)
Spiritual Sins: "idolatry, sorcery" Galatians 5:20a (NLT2)
Relational Sins: "hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissension division, envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other sins like these. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God." Galatians 5:20b-21 (NLT2)

"So I say, let the Holy Spirit <b>guide</b> your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves." <b>Galatians 5:16 (NLT2)</b>
"But those who <b>live to please</b> the Spirit will harvest <b>everlasting life</b> from the Spirit." <b>Galatians 6:8b (NLT2)</b>

2 My Thoughts "Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit. So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace." Romans 8:5-6 (NLT2)
"But the Holy Spirit <b>produces</b> this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things! <b>Galatians 5:22-23 (NLT2)</b>

3 My Passions And Desires To The Holy Spirit "Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there. Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives." Galatians 5:24-25 (NLT2)
