Big Idea: We will never find what we really need until God is enough.

"The LORD is my **shepherd**, I shall not be in want.

He makes me **lie down** in green pastures, He leads me beside quiet waters, He **restores** my soul. He **guides** me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

"Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life" Psalm 23:1-6 (NIV)
"And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28 (NIV)
"But Joseph said to them, "Don't be afraid. Am I in the place of God? You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives. 2. Move From Being Overwhelmed To "Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life" Psalm 23:1-6 (NIV)

I Find Hope In My Future When I:

1. Trust God Is Good And Is Watching Over Me

"Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life..." Psalm 23:1-6

Read Romans 8:28

Read Genesis 50:19-21 (NIV)

If you know Joseph's story, he was loved by his father then ripped from his home, betrayed by his brothers, sold into slavery, falsely accused of rape, thrown into prison, forgotten about and then raised up to 2nd only to Pharaoh as he saves Israel and Egypt from a devastating famine.

2. Move From Being Overwhelmed To Overflowing With Thankfulness

Suggestion for Thanksgiving Week: Monday:

"Give **thanks** to the LORD, call on **His name**; **make known** among the nations what He has done." **Psalm 105:1 (NIV)**

- Take a few minutes and make a list of what you are Thankful for.
- Write a prayer of Thanksgiving to God.

Tuesday:

"Sing to Him, sing praise to Him; tell of all his wonderful acts." Psalm 105:2 (NIV)

- Put on some Praise and Worship and sing a song to God.
- Tell someone how God has been good to you.

Wednesday:

"Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice." Psalm 105:3 (NIV)

- Spend a moment in prayer, worship God in His attributes. God is: Sovereign. Eternal. Omniscient. Omnipresent. Omnipotent. Unchanging. Righteous. Just. Love. Truth.

Thursday: Thanksgiving

"Look to the LORD and His strength; seek His face always. Remember the wonders He has done, His miracles, and the judgments He pronounced..." Psalm 105:4-5 (NIV)

- As you enjoy a Thanksgiving meal, go around the table and have each person share how God has blessed them and what they are thankful for.
