Read Ephesians 5:25-26

How did Jesus express His love for the church?

Read 1 Peter 3:7

What are some ways we can give honor to our spouse? How can we express understanding better?

Why is it important to be reminded that we are equal partners in God's gift of new life?

What warning does Peter give when we do not treat each other well?
