Read Colossians 3:1-4

2. Repent From My Earthly Behavior

Read Colossians 3:5-9

What does it mean to consider our earthly bodies as dead to these sins?

Commentary: Life Application Study Bible.

<u>3:5</u> We should consider ourselves dead and unresponsive to sexual immorality, impurity, lust, and evil desires. The warning in this verse is not against sex, but against sexual perversion. Where is the line between the two?

The Bible everywhere celebrates heterosexual, monogamous marriage as the proper situation for sexual fulfillment. Christian men and women should be open to true love—and to sexual intimacy—within the commitment to lifelong fidelity. That is God's way. The rest is dangerous and futile. Stay away. Sexual sin and perversion will drain your energies and turn your heart away from God.

3:8-10 We must rid ourselves of all evil practices and immorality. Then we can commit ourselves to what Christ teaches. Paul was urging the believers to remain true to their confession of faith. They were to rid themselves of the old life and put on the new nature given by Christ. If you have made such a commitment to Christ, are you remaining true to it?

3. Respond <u>By Putting On My New Self</u> Read Colossians 3:10-13

How much contrast is there from our earthly clothes to our new self?

Which piece of Christ's wardrobe do you need to put on the most?

Where is God renewing you?

Looking back over the last 12 months, where have you seen changes because of Jesus in your life?

Read Colossians 3:14-17

What strategy does Paul give us to put on our new nature?

What is the key to forgiving someone who has hurt you?

It would be nice if there were no more disagreements, but that isn't reality. So, how can we live in peace when there are still disagreements?

What is the difference of unity verses uniformity?

Read Colossians 3:16

Which Bible verse has been especially encouraging to you recently?

Music has always been essential to worship. Before the New Testament was canonized, the stories of Jesus and His teachings were often set to music. What are some of your favorite worship songs?

What changes would you like to make in order to honor Jesus more?
