Big Idea: We need a revival in our hearts and homes that changes our lives.

What is real faith? 1. Talk
"What good is it, my brothers, if a man claims to have faith, but has no deeds? Car such "faith" save him?" James 2:14 (NIV)
"Suppose a brother or sister is without clothes and daily food. If one of you says to him, `Go, I wish you well; keep warm and well fed,' but does nothing about his physical needs, what good is it?" James 2:15-16 (NIV)
"So you see, faith by itself isn't enough. Unless it produces good deeds, it is dead and useless." James 2:17 (NLT2)

2. Actions Speak "But someone will say, "You have faith; I have deeds." Show me your faith without deeds, and I will show you my faith by what I do." James 2:18 (NIV)
"You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe thatand shudder. You foolish man, do you want evidence that faith without deeds is useless?" James 2:19-20 (NIV)
"But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves." James 1:22 (NLT2)
Yes indeed, it is good when you obey the royal law as found in the Scriptures: "Love your neighbor as yourself." James 2:8 (NLT2)

3. Faith and Actions
Don't you remember that our ancestor Abraham was shown to be right with God by his actions when he offered his son Isaac on the altar? You see, his faith and his actions worked together. His actions made his faith complete. And so it happened just as the Scriptures say: "Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith." He was even called the friend of God. So you see, we are shown to be right with God by what we do, not by faith alone." James 2:21-24 (NLT2)
"Clearly, God's promise to give the whole earth to Abraham and his descendants was based not on his obedience to God's law, but on a right relationship with God that comes by faith ." Romans 4:13 (NLT2)
• We Are Saved Grace Faith Works God saved you by His grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; i is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago. Ephesians 2:8-10 (NLT2)

When someone claims to have faith, what he or she may have is intellectual assent—agreement with a set of Christian teachings—and as such it would be incomplete faith. True faith transforms our conduct as well as our thoughts. If our life remains unchanged, we don't truly believe the truths we claim to believe. 2:17 We cannot earn our salvation by serving and obeying God. But such actions show that our commitment to God is real. Deeds of loving service are not a substitute for, but rather a verification of, our faith in Christ.

2. Actions Speak <u>Louder Than Words</u> Read James 2:18-20

In what way is faith without deeds dead?

Read and discuss Life Application Study Bible.

2:18 At first glance, this verse seems to contradict Romans 3:28, "We are made right with God through faith and not by obeying the law." Deeper investigation, however, shows that the teachings of James and Paul are not at odds. While it is true that our good deeds can never earn salvation, true faith always results in a changed life and good deeds. Paul speaks against those who try to be saved by deeds instead of true faith; James speaks against those who confuse mere intellectual assent with true faith. After all, even demons know who Jesus is, but they don't obey him (2:19). True faith involves a commitment of your whole self to God.

3. Faith and Actions Work Together Read James 2:21-24 & See Genesis 22

How did Abraham ultimately pass his test of faith?

What are some faith moments that you have experienced?

Read and discuss Life Application Study Bible.

<u>2:21-24</u> James says that Abraham was "shown to be right with God" for what he *did* because he *believed* God (<u>Romans 4:1-5</u>). James and Paul are not contradicting but complementing each other. Let's not conclude that the truth is a blending of these two statements. We are not justified by what we do in any way. True faith always results in good deeds, but the deeds do not justify us. Faith brings us salvation; active obedience demonstrates that our faith is genuine.
