To Have a Clearer Vision of Jesus, I need to See Him with Holy Awe

- Jesus is Coming with the Clouds of Heaven with Power and Glory "Look, He is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him; and all the peoples of the earth will mourn because of Him. So shall it be! Amen." Revelation 1:7 (NIV) [Zechariah 12:10, Daniel 7]
- "... they will see the SON OF MAN **COMING ON THE CLOUDS** OF THE SKY with **power** and **great glory." Matthew 24:30 (NASB)**
- Jesus is the Alpha and Omega, the Almighty, Eternal
 "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty." Revelation 1:8 (NIV)
 - "Like a Son of Man" <u>Jesus will Rule for Eternity</u>

I turned around to see the voice that was speaking to me. And when I turned I saw seven golden lampstands, and among the lampstands was someone "like a son of man," Revelation 1:12-13a

"As my vision continued that night, I saw someone like a **son of man** coming with the **clouds of heaven**. He approached the **Ancient One** and was led into His presence. He was given **authority**, **honor**, **and sovereignty** over all the nations of the world, so that people of every race and nation and language would obey him. **His rule is eternal**—it will never end. • Jesus is Our High Priest

"...dressed in a **robe** reaching down to his feet and with a **golden sash** around his chest." **Revelation 1:13b (NIV)**

"So then, since we have a great **High Priest** who has entered heaven, **Jesus** the Son of God, let us hold firmly to what we believe. This High Priest of ours **understands our weaknesses**, for He faced all of the same testings we do, yet **He did not sin**. So let us come boldly to the throne of our **gracious God**. There we will receive **His mercy**, and we will find **grace** to **help us** when we need it most." **Hebrews 4:14-16 (NLT2)**

• Jesus Is Holy and Full of Wisdom

"His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow." Revelation 1:14 (NIV)

"I watched as thrones were put in place and the Ancient One sat down to judge. His clothing was as **white as snow**, **His hair like purest wool**. He sat on a fiery throne with wheels of blazing fire" **Daniel 7:9 (NLT2)**

• Jesus Judges and Atones for Our Sin

"..and his eyes were like blazing fire His feet were like bronze glowing in a furnace." Revelation 1:14b-15a (NIV) [Exodus 38:1-2]

Jesus Has the Voice of God

"and his voice was like the sound of rushing waters." Revelation 1:15b (NIV)

"Then the man brought me to the gate facing east, and I saw the **glory of the God** of Israel coming from the east. **His voice** was like the roar of rushing waters, and the land was radiant with his glory." **Ezekiel 43:1-2 (NIV)**

• Jesus Will <u>Judge His People and Those Who Attack His People</u>
"In His right hand **He held seven stars**, and out of his **mouth** came a **sharp double-edged sword**. **His face** was **like the sun** shining in all its brilliance."

Revelation 1:16 (NIV)

"For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the **thoughts and intentions of the heart**." **Hebrews 4:12 (NASB)**

I am the <u>Living One</u>; I was dead, and behold I am alive for ever and ever! And I hold the keys of death and Hades." Revelation 1:17-18 (NIV)

- Jesus is The <u>First & Last</u>. The <u>Living One</u>. He <u>Holds the Keys to Death</u> Revelation 1:17-18
- 2. John is described in the Gospels as one of the three apostles who enjoyed a special relationship with Jesus. Of all the apostles, he was probably the closest to Jesus. How could John know Jesus so well and yet be awed by him?
- 3. Revelation describes a vision of our risen and powerful Lord. Meeting Christ might be an anxious experience for some; others might even decline if they had the opportunity. And yet one day we all will see him face to face, when he returns or when we die. It would be tragic for us to be unprepared, having neglected him during our lifetime. What do we need to do now to be ready to meet Christ?
- 4. John was also facing a time of persecution. He was in exile on the island of Patmos. How do times of persecution affect a person's attitude and outlook on life? How would the presence of Jesus, as He is seen here, affect the depression and disappointment felt by an exile?
- 5. How does Jesus make His presence felt in my life?
- 6. This vision came as a surprise to John. How has Jesus surprised me lately?

- 7. Which of Jesus' titles mentioned in this chapter is most meaningful to me?
- 8. Which of these attributes do I most need to keep in mind?

What can I do to keep these characteristics of Jesus in mind as I go through this week?

- 9. What attribute of Christ am I most grateful for? Select one, and express my gratitude for that attribute each day this week.
- 10. Using the analogy of a lighting fixture, what would help us create more light as a church?
