Big Idea: God extends His mercy with a final countdown before He judges the World.

"If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you." **John 15:18-19 (NIV)**

What Jesus Says To A Suffering Church:

"To the angel of the church in Smyrna write: These are the words of him who is the First and the Last, who died and came to life again. I know your afflictions and your poverty--yet you are rich! I know the **slander** of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan." **Revelation 2:8-9 (NIV)**

- Poverty
- o Slander
- o **Prison**
- o Death

"Therefore, it was necessary for Him to be made in every respect like us, His brothers and sisters, so that He could be our **merciful and faithful** High Priest before God. Then he could offer a sacrifice that would **take away the sins** of the people. Since he Himself has gone through suffering and testing, He is able to help us when we are being tested." **Hebrews 2:17-18 (NLT2)**

"You, however, know all about my teaching, my way of life, my purpose, faith, patience, love, endurance, persecutions, sufferings--what kinds of things happened to me in Antioch, Iconium and Lystra, the persecutions I endured. Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them. In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, while evil men and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived." **2 Timothy 3:10-13 (NIV)**
