Final Countdown: The Book Of Revelation "What Jesus Says To A Dead Church" #7 (How To Bring Faith Back To Life) Cornerstone Church of Poway Pastor Ed Turley September 13, 2020

Big Idea: God extends His mercy with a final countdown before He judges the World.

"To the angel of the church in Sardis write: These are the words of him who holds the seven spirits of God and the seven stars. I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead. **Wake up!**" **Revelation 3:1-2a (NIV)**

Four Action Steps To Bring Back To Life What Seems Dead:

I. Examine The Gap Between My Reputation And Reality "Wake up!" Revelation 3:2a (NIV)

"Instead, let us test and **examine** our ways. Let us turn back to the LORD." **Lamentations 3:40 (NLT2)**

"Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results." James 5:16 (NLT2)

2. <u>Strengthen</u> The Few Good Things I Do Have

"Strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have not found your deeds complete in the sight of my God. Remember, therefore, what you have received and heard; obey it..." Revelation 3:2b-3a (NIV)

"Therefore put on the **full armor of God**, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. **Stand firm** then, with the belt of **truth** buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of **righteousness** in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the **gospel of peace**. In addition to all this, take up the shield of **faith**, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of **salvation** and the sword of the Spirit, which is the **word** of God. And **pray** in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.

3. Repent And Choose To Take A Step In The Right Direction

"Repent. But if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what time I will come to you." Revelation 3:2b-3 (NIV)

"When you lift up your hands in prayer, I will not look. Though you offer many prayers, I will not listen, for your hands are covered with the blood of innocent victims. **Wash** yourselves and be clean! Get your sins out of my sight. **Give up your evil ways**. Learn to **do good**. **Seek justice**. **Help the oppressed**. **Defend** the cause of orphans. Fight for the **rights of widows**. "Come now, let's settle this," says the LORD. "Though your sins are like scarlet, I will make them as white as snow. Though they are red like crimson, I will make them as white as wool." Isaiah 1:15-18 (NLT2)

4. Be Prepared For The Return Of Jesus

"Yet you have a **few** people in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes. They will **walk with me**, dressed in white, for they are worthy. He who **overcomes** will, like them, be **dressed in white**. **I will never blot out his name** from the book of life, but will **acknowledge** his name before my Father and his angels. He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. **Revelation 3:4-6 (NIV)**

"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter. "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'" Matthew 7:21-23 (NASB)
