Big Idea: Our families are not the enemy. We must battle against the devil, our culture and our flesh for the future of our families.

1. The Devil Schemes To <u>Undermine</u> Our Relationships With God And Others "In your anger do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold." **Ephesians 4:26-27 (NIV) Remember Verse**

"For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places." **Ephesians 6:12 (NLT2)**

Family Warfare Prayer [based on Ephesians 4]

"Dear Lord, soften our hearts and open our minds to hear from You. Remind us that our family is not the enemy. Our real enemy is the devil and he is a defeated foe. Your Word teaches us that the devil tries to get a foothold in our relationships when we harbor negative emotions. He uses our old habits and weaknesses as an opportunity to divide us. We confess that we have allowed our former way of life with anger, lust and deception to create an opportunity for the devil to harm our relationships. In the name of Jesus, we rebuke the enemy and ask for your grace and mercy. We ask forgiveness for falsehood, anger, hurtful words, and bitterness. We pray for a renewing of our thoughts and attitudes to reflect your holiness. Lord, give us your truth, compassion, kindness and a heart to forgive as you have forgiven us." Amen
