I Can Walk In Freedom By:

1. Avoiding Halfhearted Obedience

Sin is no longer your master, for you no longer live under the requirements of the law. Instead, you live under the freedom of God's grace. Well then, since God's grace has set us free from the law, does that mean we can go on sinning? Of course not! Romans 6:14-15 (NLT2)

Live as free men, but do not use your freedom as a cover-up for evil; live as servants of God. 1 Peter 2:16 (NIV)

2. Choosing <u>To Live Rightly</u>

"Don't you realize that you become the **slave** of whatever you **choose** to obey? You can be a **slave to sin**, which **leads to death**, or you can choose to **obey God**, which leads to **righteous living**. **Romans 6:16 (NLT2)**

Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." Matthew 22:37-40 (NIV)

3. Choosing Wholehearted Obedience

Thank God! Once you were slaves of sin, but now you **wholeheartedly** obey this teaching we have given you. Now you are **free** from your slavery to sin, and you have **become slaves to righteous living.** Because of the weakness of your human nature, I am using the **illustration** of slavery to help you understand all this. **Previously**, you let yourselves be **slaves to impurity and lawlessness**, which led ever deeper into sin. Now **you must give yourselves** to be **slaves to righteous living** so that you will become holy. **Romans 6:17-19 (NLT2)**

When you were slaves to sin, you were free from the obligation to do right. And what was the result? You are **now ashamed** of the things you used to do, things that end in eternal doom. **Romans 6:20-21 (NLT2)**

My old self has been **crucified** with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but **Christ lives in me**. So I live in this earthly body by **trusting** in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." **Galatians 2:20 (NLT2)**

The Power Of Spiritual Momentum

But now you are free from the power of sin and have become slaves of God. Now you do those things that lead to holiness and result in eternal life. For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:22-23 (NLT2)
