Sermon Teaching

Big Idea: If we want real life change, we must allow God's Word to transform us.

> Cornerstone's mission is to help people find and follow Jesus.

Therefore go and **make disciples** of **all nations**, **baptizing** them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and **teaching** them to obey everything I have commanded you." **Matthew 28:19-20 (NIV)**

"For I am not ashamed of this **Good News about Christ**. It is the power of God at work, **saving everyone who believes**—the Jew first and also the Gentile. This Good News tells us how God makes us right in his sight. This is accomplished from start to finish **by faith**. As the Scriptures say, "It is through **faith** that a righteous person has life." **Romans 1:16-17 (NLT2)**

The Message We Must Preach Is:

1. Our Sin Separates Us From God

"For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened. Although they claimed to be wise, they became fools and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images made to look like mortal man and birds and animals and reptiles. Furthermore, since they did not think it **worthwhile** to retain the knowledge of God, He gave them over to a **depraved mind**, to do what ought not to be done... They have become **filled with every kind of wickedness**, evil, greed and depravity. They are full of envy, murder, strife, deceit and malice. They are gossips, slanderers, Godhaters, insolent, arrogant and boastful; they invent ways of doing evil; they disobey their parents; they are senseless, faithless, heartless, ruthless. Although they know God's righteous decree that those who do such things deserve death, they not only **continue** to do these very things but also **approve** of those who practice them."

Romans 1:21-23, 28-32 (NIV)

"What shall we conclude then? Are we any better? Not at all! We have already made the charge that Jews and Gentiles alike are **all under sin**. As it is written: "There is **no one righteous**, not even one; there is no one who understands, no one who seeks God. All have turned away, they have together become worthless; there is no one who does good, not even one." **Romans 3:9-12 (NIV)**

2. God Would Rather Save Us Than Judge Us

"For God so **loved** the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall **not perish** but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to **save** the world through him." **John 3:16-17 (NIV)**

Yet God, with undeserved kindness, declares that we are righteous. He did this through Christ Jesus when He freed us from the penalty for our sins. For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood. This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when He held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past, for He was looking ahead and including them in what he would do in this present time. God did this to demonstrate his righteousness, for He himself is fair and just, and He declares sinners to be right in his sight when they believe in Jesus." Romans 3:24-26 (NLT2)
