Big Idea: If we want real life change, we must allow God's Word to transform us.

We Can Experience Transforming Love By:

1. Choosing A <u>Higher Standard</u>

"Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good." Romans 12:9 (NIV)

Jesus said, "I know your deeds, your **love** and **faith**, your **service** and **perseverance**, and that you are now doing more than you did at first. Nevertheless, I have this against you: You **tolerate** that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess. By her **teaching** she **misleads** my servants into **sexual immorality** and the eating of food sacrificed to idols." **Revelation 2:19-20 (NIV)**

"Be **devoted** to one another in **brotherly love**. **Honor** one another above yourselves. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your **spiritual fervor**, **serving** the Lord. **Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer**. **Share** with God's people who are in need. **Practice hospitality**." **Romans 12:9-13 (NIV)**

"This is love: not that we loved God, but that He **loved us** and sent his Son as an **atoning sacrifice** for our sins. Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also **ought** to **love one another**. No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and His love is made **complete** in us." **1 John 4:9b-12 (NIV)**

2. Becoming A Peacemaker

"Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. **Rejoice** with those who rejoice; **mourn** with those who mourn. **Live in harmony** with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited. Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everybody. If it is possible, **as far as it depends on you**, **live at peace with everyone.**" **Romans 12:14-18 (NIV)**

3. Letting Go Of Past Hurts

"Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord. On the contrary: "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head." Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."
