Big Idea: If we want real life change, we must allow God's Word to transform us.

"Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples." John 13:35 (NLT2)

"My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them **may be one**, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me." **John 17:20-21 (NIV)**

We Can Build Unity By:

1. Being Supportive Of Others Who Have A Heavy Load

"We who are strong ought to **bear with the failings of the weak** and not to please ourselves. Each of us should please his neighbor **for his good**, **to build him up.** For even Christ **did not please himself** but, as it is written: 'The insults of those who insult you have fallen on me.'" **Romans 15:1-3 (NIV)**

"Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ. If you think you are too important to help someone, you are only fooling yourself. You are not that important. Pay careful attention to your own work, for then you will get the satisfaction of a job well done, and you won't need to compare yourself to anyone else. For we are each responsible for our own conduct."

Galatians 6:2-5 (NLT2)

2. Accepting Each Other As He Has Accepted Us

"For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope. May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a spirit of unity among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus, so that with one heart and mouth you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God." Romans 15:4-7 (NIV) "If you have any encouragement from **being united with Christ**, if any **comfort** from **his love**, if any **fellowship with the Spirit**, if any **tenderness and compassion**, then make my joy complete by being **like-minded**, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose. Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the **interests of others**."

Philippians 2:1-4 (NIV)

"In this new life, it doesn't matter if you are a Jew or a Gentile, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbaric, uncivilized, slave, or free. **Christ is all that matters**, and He lives in all of us." **Colossians 3:11 (NLT)**

3. Worshiping Together As God's Family

"For I tell you that Christ has become a servant of the Jews on behalf of God's truth, to confirm the promises made to the patriarchs so that the Gentiles may glorify God for his mercy, as it is written: "Therefore I will praise you among the Gentiles; I will sing hymns to your name." Again, it says, "Rejoice, O Gentiles, with his people." And again, "Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles, and sing praises to Him, all you peoples." And again, Isaiah says, "The Root of Jesse will spring up, one who will arise to rule over the nations; the Gentiles will hope in him." May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit." Romans 15:8-13 (NIV)

"Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord, always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ." **Ephesians 5:19-21 (NIV)**
