We Can Demonstrate Love By:

1. Giving Emotional Support

"Do not rebuke an older man harshly, but exhort him as if he were your father. Treat younger men as brothers, older women as mothers, and younger women as sisters, with absolute purity." **1 Timothy 5:1-2 (NIV)**

"Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus." **Philippians 2:4-5 (NIV)**

"However, each one of you also must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband." **Ephesians 5:33 (NIV)**

"Husbands, in the same way be **considerate** as you live with your wives, and treat them with **respect** as the weaker **partner** and as **heirs** with you of the gracious gift of life, so that nothing will hinder your prayers." **1 Peter 3:7 (NIV)**

2. Providing For Needs

"Give proper recognition to those widows who are really in need. But if a widow has children or grandchildren, these should learn first of all to put their religion into practice by caring for their own family and so repaying their parents and grandparents, for this is pleasing to God. The widow who is really in need and left all alone puts her hope in God and continues night and day to pray and to ask God for help." **1 Timothy 5:3-5 (NIV)**

"If anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for his immediate family, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever." **1 Timothy 5:8 (NIV)**

"Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers." **Galatians 6:10 (NIV)**

Practice hospitality." **Romans 12:9-13 (NIV)**
