How Can I Become More Teachable?

1. Teachable People Are Learners

Intelligent people are always ready to learn. Their ears are open for knowledge.

Proverbs 18:15 (NLT2)

The key to being a good learner:

F - Faithful

A - Available

T - Teachable

Listen to the words of the wise; apply your **heart** to my instruction. For it is good to keep these sayings in your heart and always ready on your lips. I am teaching you today—yes, you— so you will trust in the LORD. I have written thirty sayings for you, filled with advice and knowledge.

Proverbs 22:17-20 (NLT2)

This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, expressing spiritual truths in spiritual words.

2. Teachable People Are Humble

Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NLT2)

Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth. **Psalm 46:10 (NIV)**

Get all the advice and instruction you can, so you will be wise the rest of your life. You can make many plans, but the LORD's purpose will prevail. Loyalty makes a person attractive. It is better to be poor than dishonest. Fear of the LORD leads to life, bringing security and protection from harm.

Proverbs 19:20-23 (NLT2)

Instruct the wise, and they will be even wiser. Teach the righteous, and they will learn even more. **Proverbs 9:9 (NLT2)**

Plans go wrong for lack of advice; many advisers bring success.

Proverbs 15:22 (NLT2)

Fools have no interest in understanding; they only want to air their own opinions. **Proverbs 18:2 (NLT2)**

Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like a man who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. But the man who looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues to do this, not forgetting what he has heard, but doing it--he will be blessed in what he does. **James 1:22-25 (NIV)**
