2. Focus On Sharing Jesus With Others

And I want you to know, my dear brothers and sisters, that everything that has happened to me here has helped to **spread the Good News**. For everyone here, including the whole palace guard, knows that I am in chains because of Christ. And because of my imprisonment, most of the believers here have gained confidence and **boldly speak God's message** without fear.

Philippians 1:12-14 (NLT2)

It's true that some are preaching out of jealousy and rivalry. But others preach about Christ with pure motives. They preach because they love me, for they know I have been appointed to **defend the Good News**. Those others do not have pure motives as they preach about Christ. They preach with selfish ambition, not sincerely, intending to make my chains more painful to me. But that doesn't matter. Whether their motives are false or genuine, **the message about Christ is being preached either way, so I rejoice**. And I will continue to rejoice. **Philippians 1:15-18 (NLT2)**

3. Gain Strength From Each Other To Live In A Worthy Manner

Above all, you must live as citizens of heaven, conducting yourselves in a manner worthy of the Good News about Christ. Then, whether I come and see you again or only hear about you, I will know that you are standing side by side, fighting together for the faith, which is the Good News. Don't be intimidated in any way by your enemies. This will be a sign to them that they are going to be destroyed, but that you are going to be saved, even by God himself. For you have been given not only the privilege of trusting in Christ but also the privilege of suffering for him. We are in this struggle together. You have seen my struggle in the past, and you know that I am still in the midst of it. Philippians 1:27-30 (NLT2)

"In view of all this, make every effort to respond to God's promises. Supplement your faith with a generous provision of **moral excellence**, and moral excellence with **knowledge**, and knowledge with **self-control**, and self-control with **patient endurance**, and patient endurance with **godliness**, and godliness with **brotherly affection**, and brotherly affection with **love for everyone**. The more you grow like this, the more **productive** and useful you will be in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But those who fail to develop in this way are shortsighted or blind, forgetting that they have been cleansed from their old sins." **2 Peter 1:5-9 (NLT2)**

2. Focus On Sharing Jesus With Others Read Philippians 1:12-14

People love to complain about their problems to get sympathy. How did Paul view his difficulty being imprisoned?

Read Philippians 1:15-18

Even though some people were out to make Paul's life harder, and some were even preaching with false motives, how did Paul react to the situation?

3. Gain Strength From Each Other To Live In A Worthy Manner Read Philippians 1:27-30

How should we conduct ourselves?

Who do you have to stand side by side in your faith?

Who can you encourage this week in their faith?

Read 2 Peter 1:5-9

If you were to focus on just one attribute, which one would bless your family the most?
