The God Questions (1 of 4) "Do All Roads Lead To Heaven?" Cornerstone Church of Poway Pastor Ed Turley April 9, 2023

The angel said to the women, "**Do not be afraid**, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. ⁶ **He is not here; he has risen, just as he said**. Come and see the place where he lay. ⁷ Then go quickly and tell his disciples: **'He has risen from the dead** and is going ahead of you into Galilee. **Matthew 28:5-7a (NIV)**

Big Idea: Religion is man trying to save himself or become like God. Christianity is God saving man through the **atoning** sacrifice of Jesus Christ. When we misunderstand who God is, we fail to understand His Holiness, His Justice, and His love.

"This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an **atoning** sacrifice for our sins." 1 John 4:10 (NIV) Remember Verse

1. The Bible Teaches The Savior Will Pay For Our Sins

He was despised and rejected by men, a man of **sorrows**, and familiar with **suffering**. Like one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not. ⁴ Surely he took up **our infirmities** and **carried our sorrows**, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. ⁵ But he was **pierced for our transgressions**, he was **crushed for our iniquities**; the **punishment that brought us peace** was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed. ⁶ We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the **LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all**. **Isaiah 53:3-6 (NIV)** <u>God</u> in the Flesh "Therefore the **Lord himself** will give you a sign: The **virgin** will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call him **Immanuel**." **Isaiah 7:14 (NIV)**

"For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called **Wonderful Counselor**, **Mighty God**, **Everlasting Father**, **Prince of Peace**." **Isaiah 9:6 (NIV)**

2. Jesus Claims To The Savior of the World

Jesus said to them, "This is what I told you while I was still with you: **Everything** must be fulfilled that is written about me in the **Law of Moses**, the **Prophets** and the **Psalms**."

Then he opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures. ⁴⁶ He told them, "This is what is written: The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, ⁴⁷ and repentance and forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to **all nations**, beginning at Jerusalem. ⁴⁸ You are witnesses of these things. **Luke 24:44-48 (NIV)**

✓ Forgives Sin.

Which is easier: to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up and walk'? ⁶ But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth **to forgive sins...**" Then he said to the paralytic, "Get up, take your mat and go home." ⁷ And the man got up and went home. **Matthew 9:5-7 (NIV)**

✓ Raises The Dead.

"For just as the Father **raises the dead** and gives them life, even so the Son gives life to whom he is pleased to give it." **John 5:21 (NIV)**

✓ The <u>Judge.</u>

"Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted **all judgment to the Son**" **John 5:22 (NIV)**

✓ The <u>ONLY</u> Way To Heaven.

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me." John 14:6 (NASB)

3. Who Do You Say Jesus Is?

Now Thomas (called Didymus), one of the Twelve, was not with the disciples when Jesus came. ²⁵ So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe it." ²⁶ A week later his disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" ²⁷ Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe." ²⁸ Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!" John 20:24-28 (NIV)

"That if you **confess** with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and **believe** in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be **saved**." **Romans 10:9 (NIV)**
