Big Idea: We are saved by grace through faith in the atoning sacrifice of Jesus.

This is love: not that we loved God, but that **He loved us** and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. 1 John 4:10 (NIV) Remember Verse

We Can Have Confidence That We Are Saved Because:

1. God's Word Promises Salvation For Those Who Believe In Jesus

"And this is the testimony: God has given us **eternal life**, and this life is **in his Son**. He who **has the Son** has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. I write these things to you who **believe** in the name of the Son of God so that you may **know** that you have eternal life." **1 John 5:11-13 (NIV)**

"For it is by **grace** you have been saved, through **faith**--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God-- not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do **good works**, which God prepared in advance for us to do." **Ephesians 2:8-10 (NIV)**

"My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. ²⁸ I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand. ²⁹ My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand. ³⁰ I and the Father are one." John 10:27-30 (NIV)

2. God's Spirit Confirms We Belong To Him

"So you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when he adopted you as his own children. Now we call him, "Abba, Father." ¹⁶ For his Spirit joins with our spirit to **affirm** that we are God's children." Romans 8:15-16 (NLT2)

"If you love me, **obey** my commandments. ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another **Advocate**, who will **never leave you**. ¹⁷ He is the **Holy Spirit**, who **leads** into all truth. The world cannot receive him, because it isn't looking for Him and doesn't recognize Him. But you **know Him**, because He lives with you now and later will **be in you**." **John 14:15-17 (NLT2)**

"So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise.
¹⁶ Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days.
¹⁷ Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do.
¹⁸ Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit,
¹⁹ singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among yourselves, and making music to the Lord in your hearts.

3. God Changes Us Into A New Person

"This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! ¹⁸ And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him." **2 Corinthians 5:17-18 (NLT2)**

"We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all the saints-- the faith and love that spring from the hope that is stored up for you in heaven and that you have already heard about in the word of truth, the gospel that has come to you. All over the world this gospel is bearing fruit and growing, just as it has been doing among you since the day you heard it and understood God's grace in all its truth." Colossians 1:3-6 (NIV)
