Big Idea: To understand the Bible can be trusted because it is God-breathed truth and to take steps to read it and put it into practice.

"But even more blessed are all who **hear** the word of God and put it into **practice**." **Luke 11:28 (NLT2) Remember Verse**

We Can Trust The Bible Because:

- 1. It Contains A Unified Single Message Of The Redemption Of Mankind By Jesus The Unity of the Bible
- \checkmark The Bible was written over a period of <u>1500 years</u>
- ✓ 66 Books By 40 authors (Kings to peasants)
- ✓ In 3 different <u>languages</u>, from 3 different <u>continents</u>
- ✓ Telling **one story**. God's salvation of men through the atoning sacrifice of Jesus

Comparison:

- ✓ The Book of Mormon –single translated by Joseph Smith 1827
- ✓ The Qu'ran –writings and records of one man Muhammad
- ✓ The Hindu writings –stories of things that happened in the celestial realms
- ✓ Buddhism –Founder Siddhartha Guatama Known As Buddha 600B.C.

Revelation: God chose to reveal His nature & will

"And so I will show my **greatness** and my **holiness**, and I will **make myself known** in the sight of many nations. Then they will know that I am the LORD." **Ezekiel 38:23 (NIV)**

Inspiration: God worked in the hearts of human writers

"Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation. For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men **spoke from God** as they were carried along by the **Holy Spirit**." **2 Peter 1:20-21 (NIV)**

Illumination: The Holy Spirit works in the heart of the readers

"All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. ¹⁷ God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work."

Daniel 7:6, 8:5–8, 11:2–4 - The Rise & Fall of Four Empires + Alexander the Great

Ezekiel 26:4 (NIV) "They will destroy the walls of Tyre and pull down her towers; I will scrape away her rubble and make her a bare rock." **The Destruction of Tyre (200 yrs.)**

Israel - A Desolate Desert. Deuteronomy 29:23-25 Israel born in one day. Ezekiel 37:21; Isaiah 66:8 Israel will prosper. Ezekiel 38:12-12. Israel will be invincible. <u>Zechariah 12:3-9</u>

Otherwise, you have believed in vain. ³ For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that He appeared to Peter, and then to the Twelve. ⁶ After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep." 1 Corinthians 15:2-6 (NIV)

Discussion Starter: What is one of your favorite Bible verses? Why?

The Bible is not only the first printed book, but also the most translated, sold and read book of all time. God himself has breathed his very words through human hands onto scrolls, papyrus, paper, and electronic media. Although it took over 1500 years, 40 authors from diverse backgrounds and lifestyles, and three languages to write, it contains a unified single message: the redemption of mankind by Jesus. Jesus himself confirms the message of the Bible.

We also know that the Bible is inspired, infallible, and inerrant. You can trust the Bible because: It is historically accurate, it is scientifically accurate, it is prophetically accurate, it is thematically unified, it is confirmed by Jesus, it has survived all attacks, and it has transforming power.

Read Psalm 12:6 & Ezekiel 38:23

God took great care to preserve his words and protect the Bible from eradication. Why does this passage make you feel confident about the trustworthiness of the Bible?

How can the purity of the Bible and its unified message improve our relationship with God?

Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Knowing the care God put into protecting the Bible and maintaining its message, discuss in your group how its truth can motivate you to expand your biblical knowledge.

Read Luke 11:28

Jesus believed the Bible was true and commanded us to trust his word. What does the above verse say we are to do once we hear the word of God?

Christ came to bring God's message of salvation to people who have lost hope. How does putting the word of God into practice help you stop being a slave to your own desires?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:2-6

Who wrote this passage? How does this confirm the power of the gospel?

What are the main points of the gospel?

How would you explain the importance of Christ's resurrection to a non-believer?

Why do you think Paul went into such details of who saw Jesus after he was resurrected?

Going Deeper: Optional Read Romans 12:1-2 Read Colossians 3:16-17 What is one area in your life the Holy Spirit may be prompting you to change.

What action steps are necessary?

How can we help each other in the process?

What specific things can we do to transform our minds?

Is there an attitude you need to change?
