How To Have Jesus Bless Your Marriage

1. Invite Jesus In

On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, ² and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. ³ When **the wine was gone**, Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no more wine." ⁴ "Dear woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My time has not yet come." **John 2:1-4 (NIV)**

2. Do Whatever Jesus Tells You

⁵ His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." ⁶ Nearby stood **six stone water jars**, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons. ⁷ Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water"; so they filled them to the brim. **John 2:5-7 (NIV)**

 "Haven't you read," he replied, "that at the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female,' ⁵ and said, 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be **united** to his wife, and the two will become **one flesh'**? ⁶ So they are no longer two, but one. Therefore what God has joined together, let man not separate." **Matthew 19:4-6 (NIV)**

- Be faithful to your spouse so you will have godly children. Malachi 2:13-15
- Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. Ephesians 5:21 (NIV)
- However, each one of you also must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband. Ephesians 5:33 (NIV)
- "But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!" Galatians 5:22-25 (NLT2)

⁸ Then he told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet." They did so, ⁹ and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine. He did not realize where it had come from, though the **servants** who had drawn the water **knew**. [Jesus never touches the water...] Then he called the bridegroom aside ¹⁰ and said, "Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved **the best till now**." ¹¹ This, the First of his **miraculous signs**, Jesus performed at Cana in Galilee. He thus revealed his glory, and His disciples put their **faith** in Him. **John 2:8-11 (NIV)**

So go ahead. **Eat your food with joy**, and drink your wine with a happy heart, for God approves of this! ⁸ **Wear fine clothes, with a splash of cologne!** ⁹ **Live happily with the woman you love** through all the meaningless days of life that God has given you under the sun. The wife God gives you is **your reward** for all your earthly toil. **Ecclesiastes 9:7-9 (NLT2)**
