- ¹⁶ So, because Jesus was doing these things on the Sabbath, the Jews persecuted him.

- that **all may honor the Son** just **as they honor the Father**. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him. **John 5:22-23 (NIV)**

5:23 honor the Son. This verse gives the reason that God entrusted all judgment to the Son (v. 22), i.e., so that all men should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. This verse goes far beyond making Jesus a mere ambassador who is acting in the name of a monarch, but gives Him full and complete equality with the Father (cf. Php 2:9-11). honor the Father. Jesus turned the tables on the Jewish accusation against Him of blasphemy. Instead, Jesus affirmed that the only way anyone can honor the Father is through receiving the Son. Therefore, the Jews were the ones who actually blasphemed the Father by rejection of His Son.

Swindoll's Living Insights New Testament Commentary - John.

— 5:22-23 — Jesus is the final judge.

Ask anyone, "Who is the final judge of man?" and seldom will the answer be anything but "God." Only God can discern the intentions of the heart, because He is omniscient. Only He can weigh the value of a person without being hypocritical, because He is perfectly righteous. Only He can decide the fate of humanity, because He made us and He is sovereign. The Father has delegated all judgment to the Son, because the Son is equal with the Father. Consequently, Jesus claimed to deserve the same honor due the Father
