Big Idea: "Christ's saving grace and unifying power transforms our identity, deepens our relationships and guides our purpose."

How Do You Go From Death to Life?

1. Admit You Were Spiritually Dead

¹ As for you, you were **dead** in your **transgressions** and **sins**, ² in which you **used to live** when you **followed the ways of this world** and of **the ruler** of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient. ³ **All of us** also lived among them at one time, **gratifying the cravings** of our sinful nature and following its desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature **objects of wrath**. **Ephesians 2:1-3 (NIV)**

"What shall we conclude then? [as Jews] Are we any better? Not at all! We have already made the charge that Jews and Gentiles alike are all under sin.

As it is written: "There is **no one righteous**, not even one; ¹¹ there is **no one who understands**, **no one who seeks God**. **Romans 3:9-11 (NIV)**

2. Accept Salvation Is Only Through God's Grace

⁴ But because of his **great love** for us, God, who is **rich in mercy**, ⁵ made us **alive with Christ** even when we were dead in transgressions--it is by **grace you have been saved**. **Ephesians 2:4-5 (NIV)**

"But God **demonstrates** His own love for us in this: While we **were still** sinners, Christ died for us." **Romans 5:8 (NIV)**

⁶ And **God raised us up with Christ** and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, ⁷ in order that in the coming ages he might show the **incomparable riches of His grace**, expressed in his **kindness** to us in Christ Jesus. **Ephesians 2:6-7 (NIV)**

⁸ For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God-- ⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast. **Ephesians 2:8-9 (NIV) Remember Verse**

But when the **kindness** and **love** of God our Savior appeared, ⁵ He **saved** us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of His **mercy**. He saved us through the washing of **rebirth** and renewal by the **Holy Spirit**, ⁶ whom He **poured** out on us generously through **Jesus Christ our Savior**, ⁷ so that, having been **justified** by His grace, we might become heirs having the **hope of eternal life**. **Titus 3:4-7 (NIV)**

3. Embrace Good Works With Gratitude

¹⁰ For we are **God's workmanship**, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. **Ephesians 2:10 (NIV) Remember Verse**

¹⁴ What good is it, my brothers, if a man claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save him? ¹⁵ Suppose a brother or sister is without clothes and daily food. ¹⁶ If one of you says to him, "Go, I wish you well; keep warm and well fed," but does nothing about his physical needs, what good is it? ¹⁷ In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead. **James 2:14-17 (NIV)**

What does it mean to you that God has made us alive with Christ? How has this transformation impacted your life?

Share your personal story of how you came to understand God's grace and how it has changed you.

Read Romans 5:8

How did God demonstrate His love for us?

Read Ephesians 2:6-9

How do you understand the concept of grace as a gift? How does understanding this affect your relationship with God?

Read Titus 3:4-7
Why did God save us?

What is the Holy Spirit's role?

3. Embrace Good Works With Gratitude

Read Ephesians 2:10

How can you help someone who struggles with feeling unworthy of God's grace? Share practical ways to encourage them.

What good works do you feel God has prepared for you? How have you seen this purpose unfold in your life?

Read James 2:17

Discuss the balance between faith and works in your life. How do you ensure that your actions reflect your faith without relying on them for salvation?

Identify one specific good work you can engage in this week. How will you take the first step to act on it?

Discuss how living out your faith through good works can impact your community.

What role can the group play in this collective effort?
