Big Idea: "Christ's saving grace and unifying power transforms our identity, deepens our relationships and guides our purpose."

We Can Live Out God's Grand Design By:

1. Believing God's Plan Was Revealed In Jesus

⁹ And He made **known** to us the **mystery** of His will according to His good pleasure, which He **purposed in Christ**, ¹⁰ to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment--to bring **all things** in heaven and on earth together **under one head**, **even Christ**. **Ephesians 1:9-10 (NIV)**

"The LORD had said to Abram, "Leave your country, your people and your father's household and go to the land I will show you.² "I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.³ I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and **all peoples on earth will be blessed through you." Genesis 12:1-3 (NIV)**

The Lord says: "It is too small a thing for you to be my servant to restore the tribes of Jacob and bring back those of Israel I have kept. I will also make you a **light for the Gentiles**, that you may bring **my salvation to the ends of the earth**." **Isaiah 49:6 (NIV)**

But He was **pierced** for our **transgressions**, he was **crushed** for our **iniquities**; the **punishment** that brought us **peace** was upon him, and by his **wounds** we are **healed**. ⁶ We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD has **laid on him the iniquity of us all**. **Isaiah 53:5-6 (NIV)**

2. Embracing Our Eternal Hope

¹¹ In **Him** we were also **chosen**, having been **predestined** according to the plan of him who works out everything in **conformity** with the **purpose of his will**,

¹² in order that we, who were the first to **hope in Christ**, might be for the praise of his glory. **Ephesians 1:11-12 (NIV)**

- Clear Conscience Romans 8:1 there is no condemnation in Jesus
- Life & Peace Romans 8:6 the Holy Spirit gives life & peace
- Confidence Romans 8:31 God is for us
- Security Romans 8:39 nothing can separate us from God's love
- Power & Strength Philippians 4:13 Contentment & strength

All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is by his great **mercy** that we have been **born again**, because God raised Jesus Christ from the dead. Now we live with great expectation, ⁴ and we have a **priceless inheritance**—an inheritance that is kept in heaven for you, pure and undefiled, **beyond the reach of change and decay**. **1 Peter 1:3-4 (NLT2)**

Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. ² I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. ³ And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Now the dwelling of God is with men, and He will live with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. ⁴ He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away." **Revelation 21:1-4 (NIV)**

3. Trusting in the Holy Spirit's Seal

¹³ And you also were **included** in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having **believed**, you were marked in him with a **seal**, the promised **Holy Spirit**, ¹⁴ who is a deposit **guaranteeing** our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession--to the praise of his glory. **Ephesians 1:13-14 (NIV)**

Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. He **anointed** us, ²² set his **seal of ownership** on us, and put His **Spirit** in our hearts as a deposit, **guaranteeing** what is to come. **2 Corinthians 1:21-22 (NIV)**

The Holy Spirit:

- Fills us with a sense of God's love Romans 5:5
- Assures us that God has adopted us as his children Romans 8:15-16
- Helps us to manifest our Christlikeness Galatians 5:22-23.

Scripture: Read Ephesians 1:9-10, Genesis 12:1-3, Isaiah 49:6, Isaiah 53:5-6, 10 and Revelation 5:9

How do these scriptures help you understand God's grand plan of salvation in Jesus?

How can you see your life as part of God's bigger picture?

Since all things are to be united under Jesus; what is one practical way to promote unity in your family, church, or community?

2. Embracing Our Eternal Hope

Read Ephesians 1:11-12, 1 Peter 1:3-4 and Revelation 21:1-4 What does it mean to you to have an inheritance in Christ? What are some things that you have right now in Christ?

In the future?

How does knowing you have an eternal, secure inheritance in Christ impacts your perspective on earthly possessions and achievements?

What is one way this hope can shape your decision making?

Share a specific way to live for the praise of God's glory this week, such as an act of service, sharing your faith, or demonstrating Christ's love.

3. Trusting in the Holy Spirit's Seal

Scripture: Read Ephesians 1:13-14 and 2 Corinthians 1:21-22.

What does it mean to you to be sealed with the Holy Spirit?

How does **the assurance of the Holy Spirit's presence** affect your confidence and daily living?

Reflect on the down payment analogy. How does knowing the Holy Spirit as a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance; provide you with assurance and confidence in your faith?

Discuss The Holy Spirit's Assurance:

- Fills us with a sense of God's love Romans 5:5
- Assures us that God has adopted us as his children Romans 8:15-16
- Helps us to manifest our Christlikeness Galatians 5:22-23.

Which of the three points discussed today resonates most with you and why?

How can our group support each other in understanding and applying these principles in our lives?
