"A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹ Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil." **Ephesians 6:10-11 (NLT2) Remember Verse**

"Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, ¹⁵ and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. ¹⁶ In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ¹⁷ Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God." Ephesians 6:14-17 (NIV)

How Do We Stand Firm With The Word Of God?

We Stand Firm By:

1. Studying The Bible In Context

"For I have not hesitated to proclaim to you the **whole will** of God. ²⁸ **Keep watch** over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you **overseers**. Be **shepherds** of the church of God, which He bought with His own blood. ²⁹ I know that after I leave, savage **wolves** will come in among you and will not spare the flock. ³⁰ Even from your **own number** men will arise and **distort the truth** in order to **draw away disciples after them**. ³¹ So be on your guard! Remember that for three years I never stopped warning each of you night and day with tears." **Acts 20:27-31 (NIV)**

"Do your best to present yourself to God as one **approved**, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who **correctly handles the word of truth**. ¹⁶ Avoid **godless chatter**, because those who indulge in it will become more and more ungodly. ¹⁷ Their teaching will spread like gangrene. Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus, ¹⁸ who have **wandered away from the truth**. They say that the resurrection has already taken place, and they **destroy** the faith of some. ¹⁹ Nevertheless, God's solid foundation stands firm, sealed with this inscription: "The Lord **knows** those who are His," and, "Everyone who **confesses** the name of the Lord must **turn away** from wickedness." **2 Timothy 2:15-19 (NIV)**

2. Refusing To Water Down The Truth

"Do not add to or subtract from these commands I am giving you. Just obey the commands of the LORD your God that I am giving you." **Deuteronomy 4:2 (NLT2)**

"Joyful are people of integrity, who follow the instructions of the LORD.² Joyful are those who obey His laws and search for Him with all their hearts.³ They do not compromise with evil, and they walk only in his paths.⁴ You have charged us to keep your commandments carefully." Psalm 119:1-4 (NLT2)

"For the time will come when men will not put up with **sound doctrine**. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears **want to hear**.⁴ They will turn their ears away from the **truth** and turn aside to **myths**." **2 Timothy 4:3-4 (NIV)**

3. Applying God's Word In Our Everyday Life

"The farmer sows the word. ¹⁵ Some people are like seed along the **path**, where the word is sown. As soon as they hear it, Satan comes and **takes away** the word that was sown in them. ¹⁶ Others, like seed sown on **rocky places**, hear the word and at once receive it with **joy.** ¹⁷ But since they have **no root**, they last only a short time. When **trouble or persecution** comes because of the word, they quickly fall away. ¹⁸ Still others, like seed sown among **thorns**, hear the word; ¹⁹ but the **worries** of this life, the **deceitfulness** of **wealth** and the **desires** for other things come in and choke the word, making it **unfruitful.** ²⁰ Others, like seed sown on **good soil**, hear the word, **accept it**, and produce a crop--thirty, sixty or even a hundred times what was sown." **Mark 4:14-20 (NIV)**

"Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into **practice** is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. ²⁵ The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its **foundation** on the rock. ²⁶ But everyone who hears these words of mine and **does not put them into practice** is like a **foolish man** who built his house on sand. ²⁷ The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; New York with a **great crash**." **Matthew 7:24-27 (NIV)**
