The Routine Of Sharing Our Faith:

1. Creates Consistency in Seeking God

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16 (NIV)

That if you **confess** with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and **believe** in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. ¹¹ As the Scripture says, "Anyone who trusts in him will never be put to shame." ¹² For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile---the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, ¹³ for, "**Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved**." ¹⁴ **How**, then, can they call on the one they have **not believed in?** And how can they believe in the one of whom they **have not heard?** And how can they hear **without someone preaching to them?** ¹⁵ And how can they preach **unless they are sent?** As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!" **Romans 10:9-15 (NIV)**

2. Provides Stability During Challenging Times

We do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about the hardships we suffered in the province of Asia. We were under great pressure, far beyond our ability to endure, so that we despaired even of life. ⁹ Indeed, in our hearts we felt the sentence of death. But this happened that we might **not rely on ourselves but on God**, who raises the dead. ¹⁰ He has delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us. On him we have set our hope that he will continue to deliver us, ¹¹ as you help us by your prayers. Then many will give thanks on our behalf for the gracious favor granted us in answer to the prayers of many. **2 Corinthians 1:8-11 (NIV)**

To keep me from becoming conceited because of these surpassingly great revelations, there was given me a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me.⁸ Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me.⁹ But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.¹⁰ That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong. 2 Corinthians 12:7-10 (NIV)

3. Leads the Next Generation

Keep your **conscience clear**. Then if people speak against you, they will be ashamed when they see what a good life you live because you belong to Christ." 1 Peter 3:15-16 (NLT2)

Opening Prayer: Invite God's guidance as you discuss the importance of sharing faith.

2: Stability During Challenging Times

Read 2 Corinthians 1:8-11 and 2 Corinthians 12:7-10 together.

How does sharing your faith provide stability during personal challenges?

In what ways can sharing God's promises help you and others during difficult times?

How does the lighthouse analogy inspire you to share your faith?

3: Leading the Next Generation

Read Deuteronomy 6:4-7 and 1 Peter 3:15-16 together.

Why is it important to share faith with the next generation?

How can you actively involve younger generations in faith practices? Discuss practical ways to encourage faith-sharing in your daily life.

Read 1 Timothy 1:13-16 How can you use Paul's three-minute testimony to format your story? **WRITING MY STORY:** A testimony doesn't need to be long.
